

2007 AAPS PRESIDENTIAL GOALS

GOAL #1: PROGRAMMING

- Utilize local universities/pharma resources for seminars/programs.
- Incorporate D3I and Q X'ology into programming.
- Support joint meetings with NIH, FDA.

Annual Meeting

- Charge AMPC to take a fresh look at program content and format, including special focus on offerings for students and academic members.
- Identify additional opportunities for Annual Meeting improvement.

National Biotechnology Conference

- Conduct a complete analysis of program content, format, conference name, attendance and location.

Distance Learning

- Develop an effective distance learning program, including identification of globalization opportunities.

GOAL #2: PARTNERSHIPS

- Strengthen relationships with other associations and the FDA to enhance scientific depth and overall quality of programs and member benefits.
- Continue to develop and expand the Career Services program through partnering and strategic outreach, to provide enhanced professional development programs, services to members, and postdoc/student specific career links.

GOAL #3: PUBLICATIONS

- Provide an updated Publications Tactical Plan for AAPS' two e-journals in accordance with Finance Committee and Executive Council recommendations.
- Help define and support D3I and Q X'ology publication efforts.

GOAL #4: WEBSITE

- Assess information and service offerings on AAPS Pharmaceutica to create a tactical plan aimed to maximize member value and to support growth of international e-subscribers:
 - Evaluate the content/services that are being offered exclusively to members versus that which is available to the general public and provide recommendations for changes.
 - Upgrade/enhance research information search and delivery technology to include new, updated sources of reference and scholarly research information.
 - Implement threaded discussion/chat rooms for focus groups and discussion groups.
 - Support and promote the use of AAPS MemberNet as the primary online networking tool for members.

GOAL #5: STRATEGIC VISIONING

- Finalize the strategies to implement recommendations from the section strategic visioning process.
- Include the integration of D3I and Q X'ology into programming, services, fellowship, and partnership opportunities.
- Develop and implement communication of strategic initiatives to AAPS members.

GOAL #6: STUDENT OUTREACH

- Add five (5) new student chapters to AAPS, two of which will be international.
- Visit at least twenty (20) student chapters by AAPS staff, leadership and Visiting Scientist Program participants.
- Encourage joint (regional) meetings of student chapters and schedule EC leaders as speakers at these events.
- Develop a plan to address the issue of scientific training in pharmaceutical sciences.
